## Quads & Straight Fours

1. **Cal Sutliff** — Sykes (2014) ltwt convertible 4x/4- with quick-riggers. Weight range about 120-160 lbs average. In main bay.
2. **Spirit of 1869** — Filippi (2009) mdwt convertible 4x/4-. Weight range about 160-200 lb average. In main bay.
3. **Stuart Law** — Filippi (2013) mdwt 4x. Weight range about 160-200 lb average. In main bay.

## Doubles & Pairs

- Doubles
  1. **Alfred Bigelow** — Filippi (2002) ltwt 2x. Weight range about 140-170 lb average. Under aqueduct.
  2. **Red Ripper** — Filippi (2001) mdwt 2x. Weight range about 145-180 lb average. Under aqueduct.
  3. **Cynthia Cole** — Filippi (2007) mdwt 2x. Weight range about 150-190 lb average. In doubles/fours bay.
  4. **Paul Yager** — Filippi (2004) mdwt/hwt 2x. Weight range about 180-205 lbs. Under aqueduct.
  5. **Jack Baxter** — Filippi (2002) hwt 2x. Weight range about 190-220 lbs. In doubles/fours bay.
- Doubles/Pairs
  1. **Gretchen Ellsworth** — Sykes (2013) ltwt 2x/2- with quick-riggers. Weight range about 140-160 lbs average. In doubles/fours bay.
  2. **Tomahawk** — Filippi (2008) ltwt 2x/2-. Weight range about 145-175 lbs average. In doubles/fours bay.
  3. **Sykes 6295 2x/2-** — (2015) mdwt 2x/2- with quick-riggers. Weight range about 150-180 lbs average. Under aqueduct (soon to be named).
  4. **Ross M Wilson III** — Sykes (2015) hwt 2x/2- with quick riggers. Weight range about 180-220 lbs average. Under aqueduct.

## Singles

- Beginner/Recreational
  1. **M4** — Maas 24 (2002) all weights, up to about 240 lb. Under aqueduct.
  2. **M5** — Maas 24 (2002) all weights, up to about 240 lb. Under aqueduct.
- Recreational/Competitive
  1. **S7** — Peinert 25 (2005) lwt/mdwt, up to about 175 lb. In main bay.
  2. **S5** — Peinert 26 (2009) mdwt/hwt, up to about 200 lb. In main bay.

- Competitive
  1. *Chicadee* — Sykes (2014) ltwt, weight range about 120-145 lb. In main bay.
  2. *Sparrow* — Sykes (2011) ltwt, weight range about 140-160 lb. In main bay.
  3. *Mockingbird* — Sykes (2015) ltwt/mdwt, weight range about 145-180 lb. In main bay.
  4. *Magpie* — Sykes (2015) ltwt/mdwt, weight range about 145-180 lb. In main bay.
  5. *RedHawk* — Sykes (2014) mdwt, weight range about 150-190 lb. In main bay.
  6. *Paloma* — Sykes (2013) hwt, weight range about 180-220 lb. In main bay.

## Oars

- Sweep
  1. Set of four Concept II (Potomac red blades, oars not yet labeled), hanging in 8s bay.
- Sculling
  1. 14 sets of sculling pairs (Concept II, Croker, Dreher), each set labeled “PBC Club ##”, hanging in downstream bay.

## Note on Rowing Shoes

All new boats are outfitted with adjustable rowing shoes, which will also be used to replace older shoes as needed. These shoes have small blue or yellow (depending on shoe size) levers that extend out of the toe end of each shoe. By depressing these levers, and simultaneously pulling (or pushing) the toe section of the shoes (NOT THE HEEL SECTION), they adjust through several sizes, thus affording a near perfect fit for men's sizes 7-12 (small shoes) and 9-15 (large shoes). The smaller sets are installed in the ltwt and ltwt/mdwt boats, and the larger ones in the mdwt and hwt boats. The shoes generally adjust easily, but sometimes they do require some patience. A little window in the heel area indicates the shoe size set during adjustment.

Please remove and return club boats very carefully from their racks. Moreover, DO return them so that the red tape marks on the hulls align with the respective rack, and bows and sterns align with indicated direction at the location.
